2-year College Graduates:

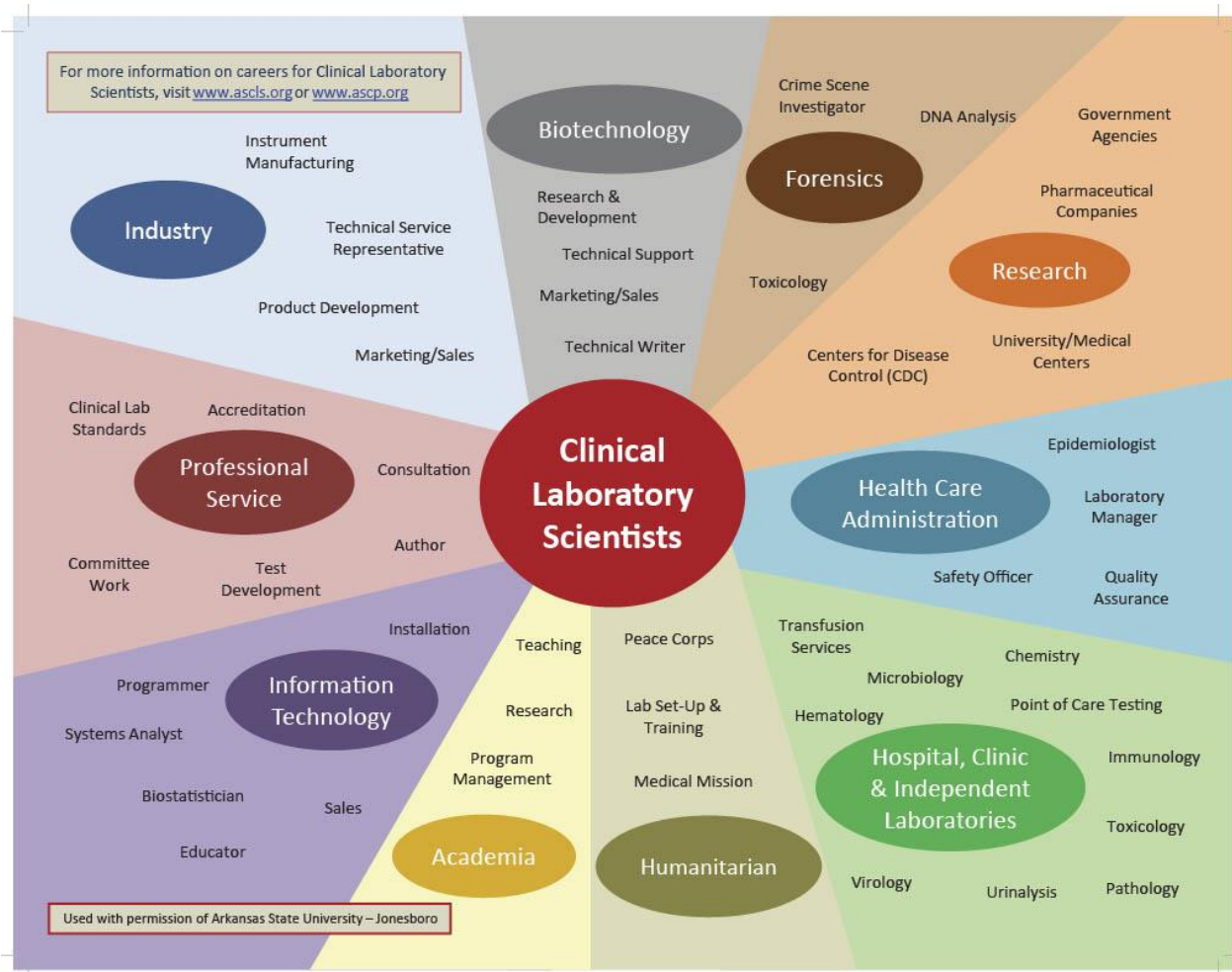
Medical Laboratory Technician*, Histotechnician, Research Technician
