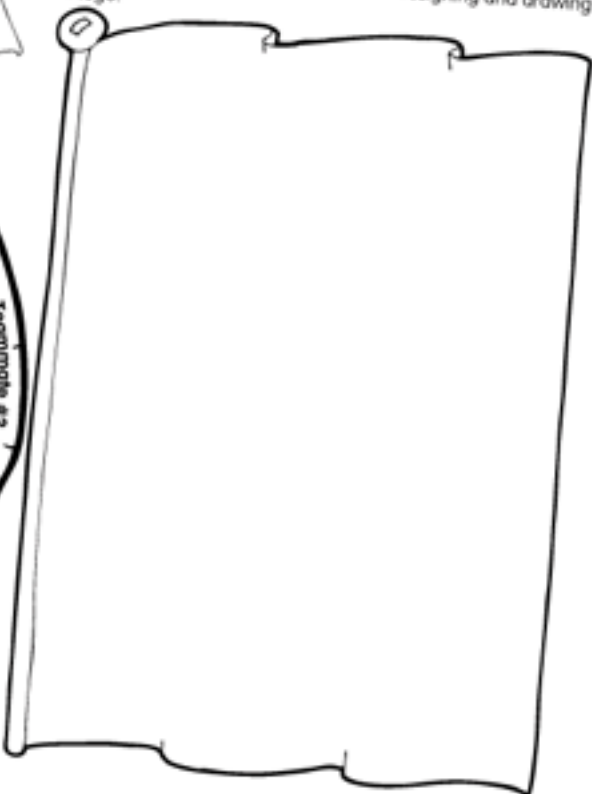
## Alike or Unique?

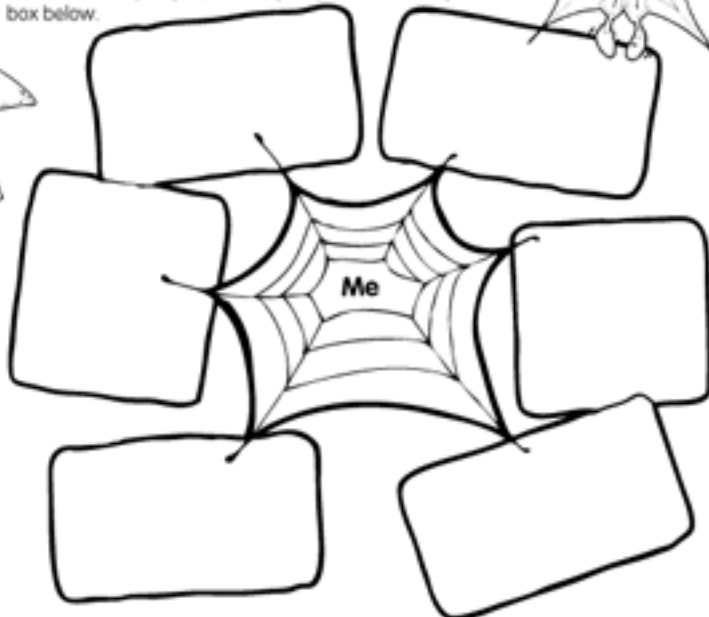
