- **10.** Ability to sell and influence others

Ninety percent of this list is made up of skills that are not specific to any one career or field. These skills are learned over a lifetime and are not acquired daily through on-the-job training. Employers are saying that the things we have traditionally taught and valued for career readiness are not what they are finding to be the most valuable in the employees they seek to hire.
