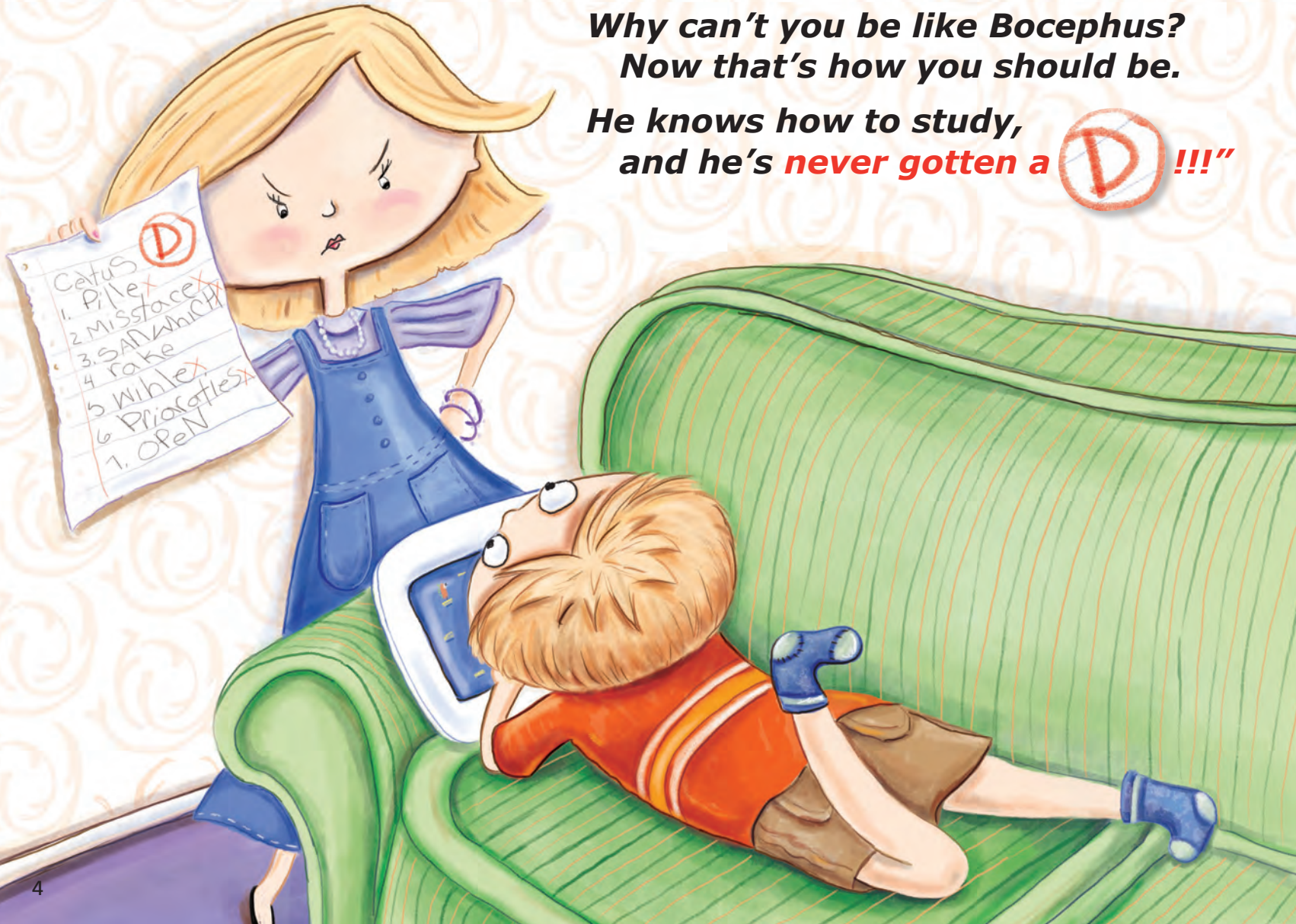

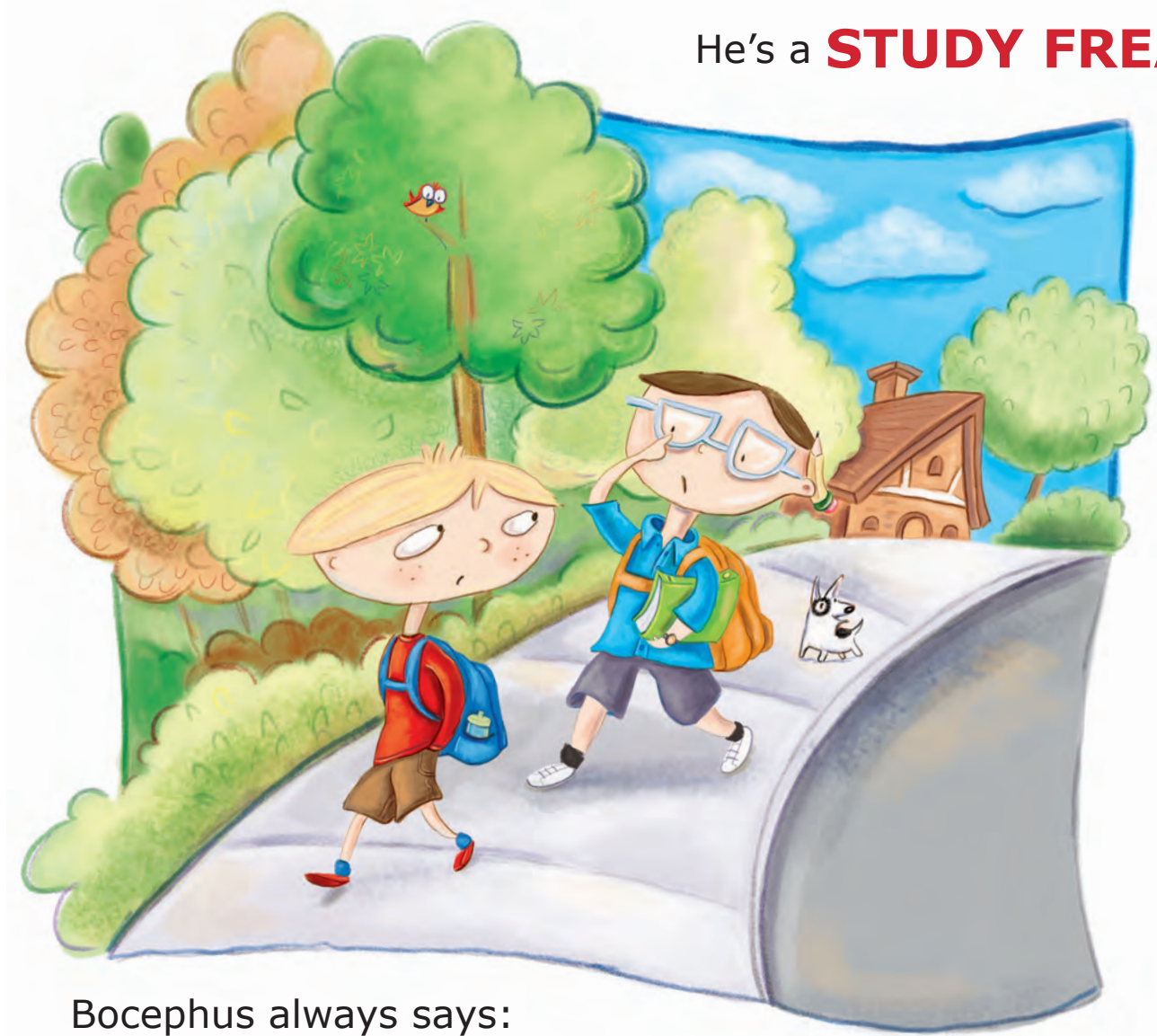

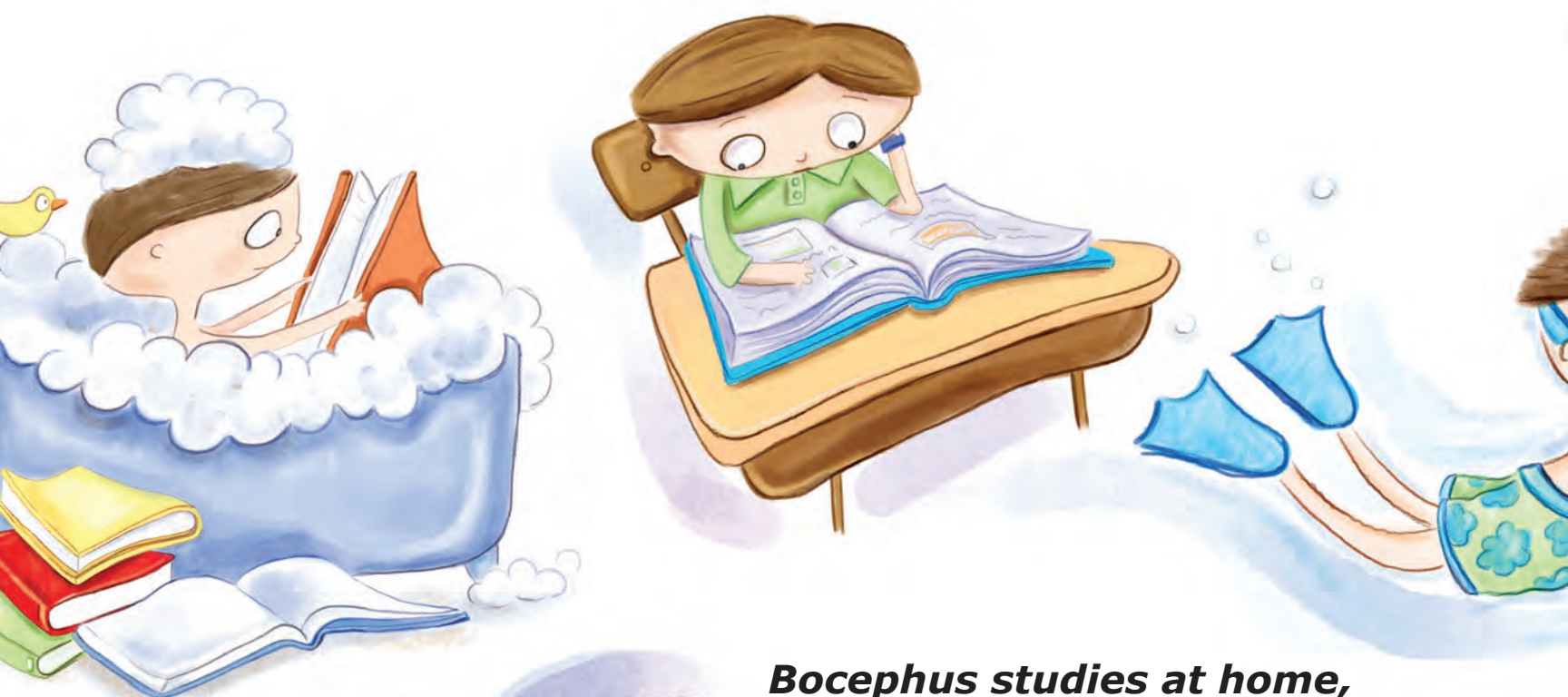
Bocephus is my cousin. He lives down the street.
